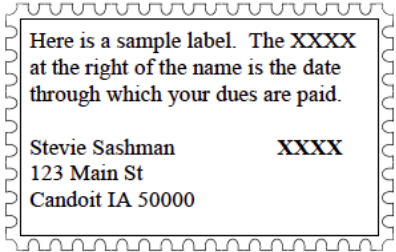

Registration information for Section Conclave is either up or will be up shortly online. We will be accepting registrations through our normal registration process on the Council website, and then registering as a contingent. The base price will be \$35 for the event, plus our Lodge transportation costs. Here is some important information to begin preparing:

- Every attendee of Section Conclave must bring two (2) copies of an up-to-date medical form. A minimum Class II physical is required.
- If you have special dietary needs, please have those ready to be entered on the registration form.
- Each Arrowman is responsible for providing their own tent.
- If you are planning to run for a Section Officer position, you will need an approval form signed by our Scout Executive. A form will be posted on our website. It is up to the individual to make arrangements to have it signed.
- If you are providing your own transportation, you will need to pay the full fee of the event plus the Lodge transportation cost. A refund may be made after the event if the main contingent's transportation costs are met.
