## **Section C-5B Conclave April 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, and 19<sup>th</sup> Camp Arrowhead**

This packet is intended to provide you with all of the information that you will need to get your lodge's contingent registered for conclave. Enclosed you will find the following forms:  
*Dietary Needs Request, Election Nomination, and Housing Needs.*

**Location-** Camp Arrowhead, 4202 State Highway DD, Marshfield, Missouri 65706

**Theme-** The theme for this year's conclave is "Remember the Past, Look to the Future". This conclave will be a great time to take a look at where our lodges have come from, and what the future holds for us. As well, it will be a fantastic time for all Arrowmen of C-5B to celebrate the Centennial in a fun "Back to the Future" themed weekend.

**Camping-** Each participant will be responsible for providing their own tents. We will be camping by lodge so your contingent members can coordinate accordingly. If any member of your contingent will have special housing needs please complete the *Housing Needs* form and send it in with your registration.

**Registration Fee-** The contingent registration fee for this year's conclave is \$40. This fee goes towards the facility costs, food costs, program costs, and a commemorative patch that each participant will take home with them at the end of the weekend.

**Check-In-** Each lodge contingent will need to provide a roster and health form for each participant upon arrival. Each individual (non-contingent) registrant will need to check-in upon arrival with their health form. It is important that every member has their medical form available upon check-in.

**Trading Post-** At the event there will be a trading post full of OA merchandise for participants to purchase. Please keep an eye out for more information.

**Meals-** As part of the event fee, the section will provide a cracker barrel on Friday, three meals and a cracker barrel on Saturday, and breakfast on Sunday. Dinner on Friday and lunch on Sunday will not be provided. If any contingent members have special dietary requests, they will need to fill out the *Dietary Needs Request* form. It is important we get these requests as soon as possible so we are able to make arrangements with the Wha-Sha-She Lodge who will be cooking for the event.

**Physical Forms-** Each delegate will need to provide two copies of their physical form to their contingent leader. One will be turned in to the section at check-in and the other should be kept by the contingent leader. A minimum of a class II physical is required for this event. All participant medications need to be brought in their original container and kept secure. If any medications require refrigeration, please bring this to our attention at check in.

**Tour Permit-** Each lodge is responsible for obtaining and abiding by a tour permit from their respective councils.

**Participant Guide Book-** Upon arrival at conclave each participant will receive a guide book that will contain the conclave schedule as well as detailed information about each activity.

**Conclave Activities-** Conclave includes a variety of events and activities ranging from Native American activities and trainings, lodge competitions, ceremonies competitions, trainings, and various other activities highlighting the centennial celebration.

**Native American Activities-** We will be offering trainings and competitions in various aspects of Native American Events.

**Lodge Competitions-** Various activities and competitions will occur throughout the day on Saturday.

**Ceremonies Competitions-** Lodges are invited to bring their ceremony teams to compete in the Pre-Ordeal Ceremony, as well as have other ceremonies critiqued by the judge to help improve each lodges ceremonies team, as well as to gather ideas from one another.

**Trainings-** There will be many fun and exciting trainings at conclave this year that will help prepare you in your home lodges.

**Uniforming-** The required uniforming for all Arrowmen is "field dress" with OA sash. This policy may be relaxed during the event and will be announced.

**Registration-** Registration will be available at <http://www.mitigwa-lodge.org> and the council website at <http://www.midiowacouncilbsa.org>. Registration will end on March 27, 2015. No Walk-ins are allowed at Section, and late mailed registrations will not be accepted. Plan accordingly.
